BOARD MINUTES FOR 12/08/87

DECEMBER 8, 1987

PURSUANT TO A SPECIAL CALL, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN AND FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY, FLORIDA, MET ON THE ABOVE DATE AT 6:00 P. M., IN THEIR REGULAR MEETING PLACE IN THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING IN CHIPLEY, FLORIDA, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT. THE ATTORNEY, CLERK AND DEPUTY CLERK, MELISSA ALFORD, WERE ALSO IN ATTENDANCE.

THE MAIN PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING WAS TO CONDUCT A WORKSHOP ON THE 911 EMERGENCY SYSTEM.

SHERIFF FRED PEEL INTRODUCED MIKE LASSITER AND TOM SHAUNESSY, REPRESENTING SOUTHERN BELL, WHO ADDRESSED THE BOARD WITH A PRESENTATION ON THE POSSIBLE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 911 EMERGENCY SYSTEM IN WASHINGTON COUNTY.

AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION BETWEEN THE BOARD, THE SHERIFF, THE REPRESENTATIVES FROM SOUTHERN BELL AND MEMBERS OF THE AUDIENCE, SHERIFF PEEL REQUESTED THAT THE BOARD ATTORNEY PREPARE AN ORDINANCE WHICH WOULD ALLOW THE COLLECTION OF LOCAL FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE 911 EMERGENCY SYSTEM. IT WAS THE CONCENSUS OF THE BOARD TO ALLOW THE ATTORNEY TO PREPARE SAID ORDINANCE FOR THE BOARD'S CONSIDERATION FOR ADVERTISEMENT PURPOSES.

AT THIS TIME, THERE WAS LENGTHY DISCUSSION BETWEEN THE BOARD AND MEMBERS OF THE AUDIENCE WHO ARE ON THE STAFF OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY HOSPITAL CONCERNING THE PRESENT STATUS OF THE HOSPITAL.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS AT THIS TIME, THE MEETING ADJOURNED.
