FEBRUARY 9, 1989

PURSUANT TO A SPECIAL CALL, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN AND FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY, FLORIDA, MET ON THE ABOVE DATE AT 7:00 P. M., IN THEIR REGULAR MEETING PLACE IN THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING, CHIPLEY, FLORIDA, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT. THE ATTORNEY, CLERK AND DEPUTY CLERK, MELISSA ALFORD, WERE ALSO IN ATTENDANCE.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AND PRAYER WAS OFFERED BY THE CHAIRMAN.

MR. FRAZIER BINGHAM AND MR. JIM BUNDY WERE PRESENT REPRESENTING BCM ENGINEERS, INCORPORATED AND MR. BINGHAM ADDRESSED THE BOARD CONCERNING THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT AND WHAT FUTURE ACTION WOULD BE EXPECTED OF THE COUNTY PURSUANT TO THE PASSAGE OF SAID ACT.

AT THIS TIME, GERALD HOLLEY, COUNTY ATTORNEY, ADDRESSED THE BOARD CONCERNING THE SITUATION BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE PREVIOUS "EMPLOYEE GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE" CARRIER AND REQUESTED AUTHORIZATION FROM THE BOARD TO CONTACT THE LEGISLATIVE AUDIT COMMITTEE AND THE AUDITOR GENERAL'S OFFICE FOR THE PURPOSE OF REQUESTING AN AUDIT OF THE RECORDS OF SAID "EMPLOYEE GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE". THE CLERK ALSO INFORMED THE BOARD THAT HIS WRITTEN REQUST HAD BEEN MADE THROUGH THE LEGISLATURE FOR THIS AUDIT AND HE HAD RECEIVED WORD EARLIER TODAY THAT THE SAME WOULD BE PERFORMED. COMMISSIONER COOK OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER JOSH DAVIS AND UNANIMOUSLY PASSED BY THE BOARD TO AUTHORIZE GERALD HOLLEY, COUNTY ATTORNEY, TO WRITE A LETTER ALSO REQUESTING SAID AUDIT.

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COMMISSIONER ALBERT DAVIS OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER COOK AND UNANIMOUSLY PASSED BY THE BOARD, TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL LEVY OF NINE DOLLARS (\$9.00) PER MONTH TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ALL RESIDENCES LYING WITHIN THE AREA INCLUDED WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT, CREATED BY COUNTY ORDINANCE 88-4, TO FUND THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE.

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RESOLUTION

ROGER D. HAGAN, BOARD ADMINISTRATOR, INFORMED THE BOARD THAT HE HAD REVIEWED THE PROPOSALS RECEIVED FOR LANDFILL CLOSURE CONSULTANTS AND HE HEAD RATED THEM FOR BOARD INFORMATION IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: 1. WILLIAM M. BISHOP 2. BCM ENGINEERS, INC. 3. B & P ENGINEERING, INC. 4. JENKINS & ASSOCIATES, INC. 5. FLORIDA ENGINEERING SERVICES CORPORATION 6. LAW ENGINEERING/TRIBBLE & RICHARDSON, INC. IT WAS THE CONCENSUS OF THE BOARD TO TABLE BOARD ACTION ON SAID PROPOSALS UNTIL THE REGULAR MEETING OF FEBRUARY 16, 1989.

COMMISSIONER CORBIN OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER COOK AND UNANIMOUSLY PASSED BY THE BOARD, AUTHORIZING TRAVIS W. PITTS, CLERK, TO EXECUTE A COUNTY WARRANT FOR ALTERNATE ROOM RESERVATIONS FOR THE BOARD MEMBERS AND BOARD ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE MEETING OF THE STATE ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ST. PETERSBURG, FLORIDA, ON FEBRUARY 22, 1989.

ACTING UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHAIRMAN, COMMISSIONER ALBERT DAVIS OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER COOK AND UNANIMOUSLY PASSED BY THE BOARD, TO APPOINT HULON CARTER TO THE WASHINGTON COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION.

ACTING UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF COMMISSIONER ALBERT DAVIS, COMMISSIONER COOK OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER CORBIN AND UNANIMOUSLY PASSED BY THE BOARD, TO APPOINT VIVIAN MCDONALD TO THE WASHINGTON COUNTY LIBRARY BOARD.

COMMISSIONER CORBIN OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ALBERT DAVIS AND UNANIMOUSLY PASSED BY THE BOARD, TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT THE DAVE TAYLOR BOAT RAMP AT GIN POND.

COMMISSIONER CORBIN OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER JOSH DAVIS AND UNANIMOUSLY PASSED BY THE BOARD TO APPROVE PAYMENT OF INVOICES TO THOMPSON TRACTOR COMPANY, INCORPORATED, IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$1,007.34 AND \$1,535.27. FOR THE REPAIR OF MOTOR GRADERS.

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ACTING UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF LIVERMORE KLEIN & LOTT, P.A., AND INFORMATION FROM THE CLERK, COMMISSIONER CORBIN OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER COOK AND UNANIMOUSLY PASSED BY THE BOARD, AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE FORMS 8038-G AND 2848 TO BE FILED WITH THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE IN CONNECTION WITH THE GOVERNMENTAL UNIT NOTE WITH THE FLORIDA LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE AUTHORITY.
