## SEPTEMBER 2, 1998

THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS IN AND FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY MET IN EMERGENCY SESSION ON THE ABOVE DATE AT 1:00 P. M. AT THE WASHINGTON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT **OPERATIONS** CENTER WITH COMMISSIONERS CARTER, BROCK, CORBIN, HALL AND DAVIS PRESENT.

CHAIRMAN CARTER CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AND STATED THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WAS TO DECLARE A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY IN WASHINGTON COUNTY DUE TO WEATHER CONDITIONS CAUSED BY HURRICANE EARL. COMMISSIONER BROCK OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HALL AND CARRIED TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR, ROGER HAGAN, UPDATED THE BOARD ON HURRICANE EARL. WHILE THE MEETING WAS IN SESSION, NOTIFICATION WAS RECEIVED THE GOVERNOR HAD ISSUED A STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO THE HURRICANE.

THE BOARD'S CONCENSUS WAS FOR THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR TO KEEP CHAIRMAN CARTER UPDATED AND WORK WITH HIM SHOULD THE WEATHER CONDITIONS CAUSED BY HURRICANE EARL BECOME MORE THREATENING.

DISCUSSION WAS HELD ON TAKING CARE OF THOSE PERSONS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS. COMMISSIONER DAVIS OFFERED A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER CORBIN AND CARRIED TO AUTHORIZE MARY ENFINGER, DIRECTOR OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY COUNCIL ON AGING, TO USE HER OWN DISCRETION IN TAKING CARE OF THOSE PERSONS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS.
