

BOARD MINUTES FOR 04/08/05

APRIL 8, 2005

THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET IN EMERGENCY SESSION ON THE ABOVE DATE WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT CHAIRMAN FINCH. COUNTY ATTORNEY GERALD HOLLEY, WAS PRESENT AS WELL AND, BY SPECIAL APPOINTMENT, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR, ROGER HAGAN, SERVED AS DEPUTY CLERK FOR THE PURPOSE OF TAKING MINUTES.

VICE CHAIRMAN COPE CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 7:30 A.M. AND TURNED THE MEETING OVER TO HAGAN FOR A BRIEFING.

HAGAN EXPLAINED THE REQUIREMENTS OF FLORIDA STATUTES 252 RELATING TO A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY. (LSE) IN THE ABSENCE OF A DISASTER DECLARATION, THE LSE MUST BE EXTENDED EVERY SEVEN DAYS.

COMMISSIONER CORBIN MADE A MOTION, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER SAPP TO EXTEND WASHINGTON COUNTY'S LSE FOR SEVEN DAYS. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

HAGAN EXPLAINED THIS IS PART OF THE PROCESS IN RECEIVING FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) ASSISTANCE. HE INFORMED THOSE PRESENT STATE AND FEDERAL ASSESSMENT TEAMS WOULD NOT ARRIVE IN WASHINGTON COUNTY BEFORE TUESDAY, APRIL 12TH.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS AT THIS TIME, THE MEETING ADJOURNED.
