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The following persons were present: Chairman Hawkins, Vice-Chairman Abbott, Commissioners Bush, and Kent, along with County Administrator Jeff Massey, County Attorney Fuqua, Fuqua & Milton, P.A., Clerk of Court Lora C. Bell, and Deputy Clerk Risha Brantley.

II. ADOPT THE AGENDA – Commissioner Bush offered a motion, seconded by Commissioner Kent, and carried to adopt the agenda.

III. NON-AGENDA – Effective October 1, 2013, Florida Statute 286.0114 mandates that members of the public shall be given a reasonable opportunity to be heard on a proposition before a Board or Commission. Each individual shall have three (3) minutes to speak on the proposition before the board. – None

IV. AGENDA ITEMS

- Request to Adopt the Bond Ordinance for Line of Credit – Tray Hawkins, Chairman read the ordinance heading. – **Commissioner Bush offered a motion, seconded by Commissioner Kent, and unanimously carried to approve ordinance 2020-25.**

V. FEMA COORDINATOR – Kevan Parker addressed the board.

- Bid for Washington County Ditch Cleaning: RFB No. 2020-002 – Chairman Hawkins refrained from voting due to his brother-in-law being the low bidder.

Kevan Parker informed the board there were five bidders for the ditch cleaning. The bidders are as follows:

1. Lagniappe Consulting LLC - Unit Price - \$2.50
2. A and W Excavations Inc. - Unit Price - \$2.75
3. Panhandle Excavating Inc. - Unit Price - \$2.95
4. Pate Farms LLC - Unit Price - \$3.27
5. North Florida Construction Inc. - Unit Price - \$5.00

The second and third bidders agreed to the low bidder unit price of \$2.50. A performance bond will be required per task order.

Commissioner Abbott offered a motion, seconded by Commissioner Bush, and carried 3-0 (Commissioner Hawkins abstained) to award the bid based on the committee's recommendation to the top three contractors which are Lagniappe Consulting, A and W Excavations Inc., and Panhandle Excavating Inc. for the unit price of \$2.50 for ditch cleaning.

- Bid for Removal of Spoil Material: RFB No. 2020-002 – Chairman Hawkins abstained from voting due to his brother-in-law being the low bidder.

Kevan Parker suggested to award to the top four bidders subject

to the contractors lowering their bid to the lowest unit price of \$6.00. The unit price for bidders three and four are the same. The bidders are as follows:

1. Lagniappe Consulting LLC - Unit Price \$6.00
2. Pate Farms LLC - Unit Price \$7.50
3. A and W Excavations Inc. - Unit Price \$8.00
4. Panhandle Excavating Inc. - Unit Price \$8.00
5. North Florida Construction Inc. - Unit Price \$20.00

**Commissioner Abbott offered a motion, seconded by Commissioner Bush, and carried 3-0 (Commissioner Hawkins abstained) to award to Lagniappe Consulting LLC, Pate Farms LLC, A and W Excavations Inc., and Panhandle Excavating Inc. based on the low bidder unit price of \$6.00 for spoil material.**

- Bid for Washington County Culvert HMP (Rip Rap Installation): RFB No. 2020-003 – Kevan Parker informed the board five bids were received. The lowest bids were A and W for \$370,000.00 and Panhandle for \$451,000.00.

Kevan Parker suggested to award to the lowest bidder. A blanket permit will be requested from the Army Core.

**Commissioner Abbott offered a motion, seconded by Commissioner Kent, and unanimously carried to award the bid to A and W Excavations Inc. for contractual services for the rip rap for Washington County.**

- VI. ADJOURN – Commissioner Abbott offered a motion, seconded by Commissioner Kent, and carried to adjourn.
